**This MaineHousing Notice is being issued to notify CAA's that an updated version of the LEAD Guide has been posted to the partner portal and below are some changes that are highlighted.**

### 1. Changes highlighted in the updated LEAD Guide include:

1. Changed the relocation per unit amount from \$1,250.00 to \$1,450.00 per unit.
2. If a vacant unit is not available or client is unable to stay with friends/family, relocation is only allowed in a hotel or motel.
3. DHHS (State Lead) guidance has been added. Only units with a MaineCare eligible child can be funded with state DHHS lead abatement.
4. CAA has fourteen (14) days from the clearance date to submit a copy of the completed Form M to ShareFile.
5. Files uploaded to ShareFile will automatically delete after two weeks from date of upload.
6. Various formatting and grammar edits
